Escanaba-Chicago Rail Connection

Pilot and Scale-Up Project

- 1. Operating between Escanaba (vicinity) and Chicago, likely <u>Chicago Junction Railway</u>, Elk Grove Village O'Hare, as Escanaba-Chicago Rail Connection ("ECRC")?
- 2. Modeled on <u>Florida East Coast Railway Intermodal</u> (*Trains*, June 2018, pp. 40-47) with potential intermediate service at Pembine, Green Bay, WI, and/or other intermediate points?
- 3. Operations may include carload, TOFC, COFC and transload services?
- 4. Shipper participation and feasibility planning based on aggregated Actionable Shipper Data developed through Michigan Technological University / Lake States Shipper Association Data Co-op Project 2018-2019?
- 5. Pilot and scale-up, in cooperation with the Northwoods Rail Transit Commission ("NRTC"), potentially supported, in-part, by public grants for rail and rail-related infrastructure based on direct public benefit return-on-investment ("PBROI"), e.g., <u>A Wisconsin Forests and Freight Rail Preservation Program</u>?
- 6. Scale-up may include potential compatibility with. and application of, Precision Scheduled Railroading ("PSR") principles and standards?
- 7. Pilot and scale-up, rolling stock acquisition potentially based PBROI investment, public-private coordination and/or ownership through NRTC and/or Lake States Shippers Association, a classic co-op shippers association?
- 8. Develop and promote the concept or theme of rail as bridge between urban and rural?
- 9. Engage the <u>Great Lakes Forests Region</u> development professionals through NRTC and potential <u>NRTC project initiatives</u> and collaborating organizations?
- 10. Explore sources and uses of "seed money" public and private funding for feasibility planning and development of an Escanaba-Chicago Rail Connection and funding for Phase Two expansion of the MI Tech / LSSA Data Co-op Project?
